Please dress for the weather and wear clothes that you don't mind getting dirty. Bring a jacket in case of rain. To protect your legs (as there will be a lot of bending and kneeling) we recommend trousers rather than shorts.

Please wear sturdy footwear that covers your feet and supports your ankles (not high heels, sandals, wellies or soft fabric shoes such as Uggs or Converse). Steel capped boots are the ideal, but otherwise we recommend walking boots or similar.
